 If you do not have the latest version of Microsoft Remote Desktop, Download and Install Microsoft Remote Desktop version 8.0.18 <u>https://itunes.apple.com/us/app/microsoft-remote-</u> <u>desktop/id715768417?mt=12</u> from the Mac App Store.



3. Click the + sign and enter the following information:
