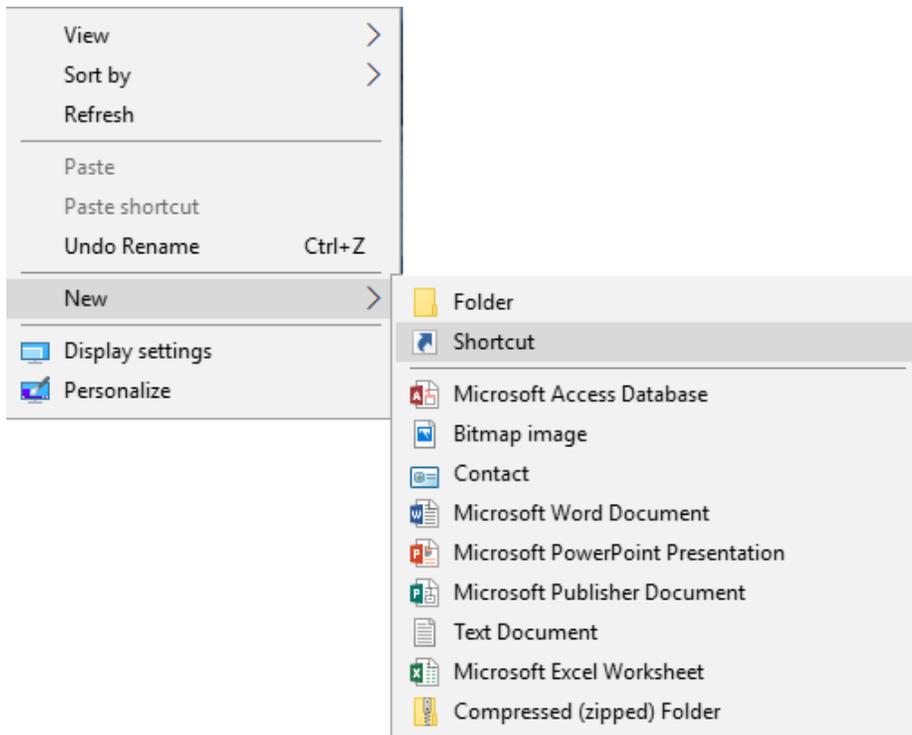


# How to Connect to the H: Drive on a Windows 10 Laptop

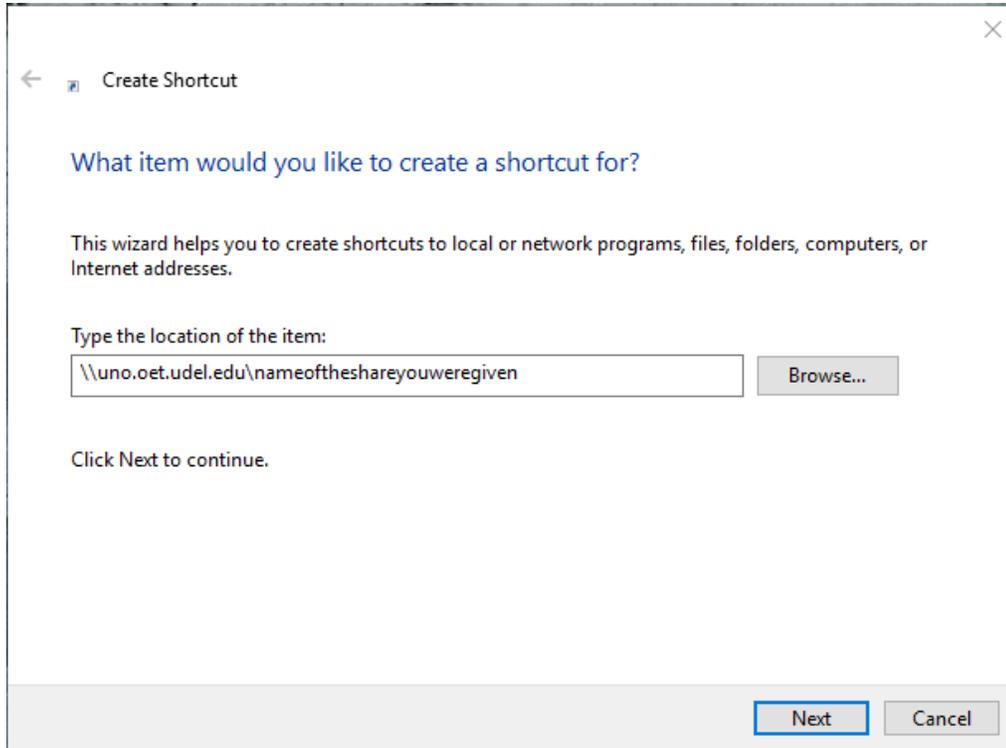
Please note: On campus, if you have a laptop, you will need to be on the Eduroam wireless access point or use a hard-wired Ethernet connection to reach the OET network. You can access Eduroam by following the directions at <http://www1.udel.edu/it/help/connecting/eduroam/>.

Off campus, you will need to download, install, and connect to the AnyConnect VPN first using your UDelNet ID, password and 2FA code. The VPN may be downloaded from [www.udel.edu/udeploy](http://www.udel.edu/udeploy).

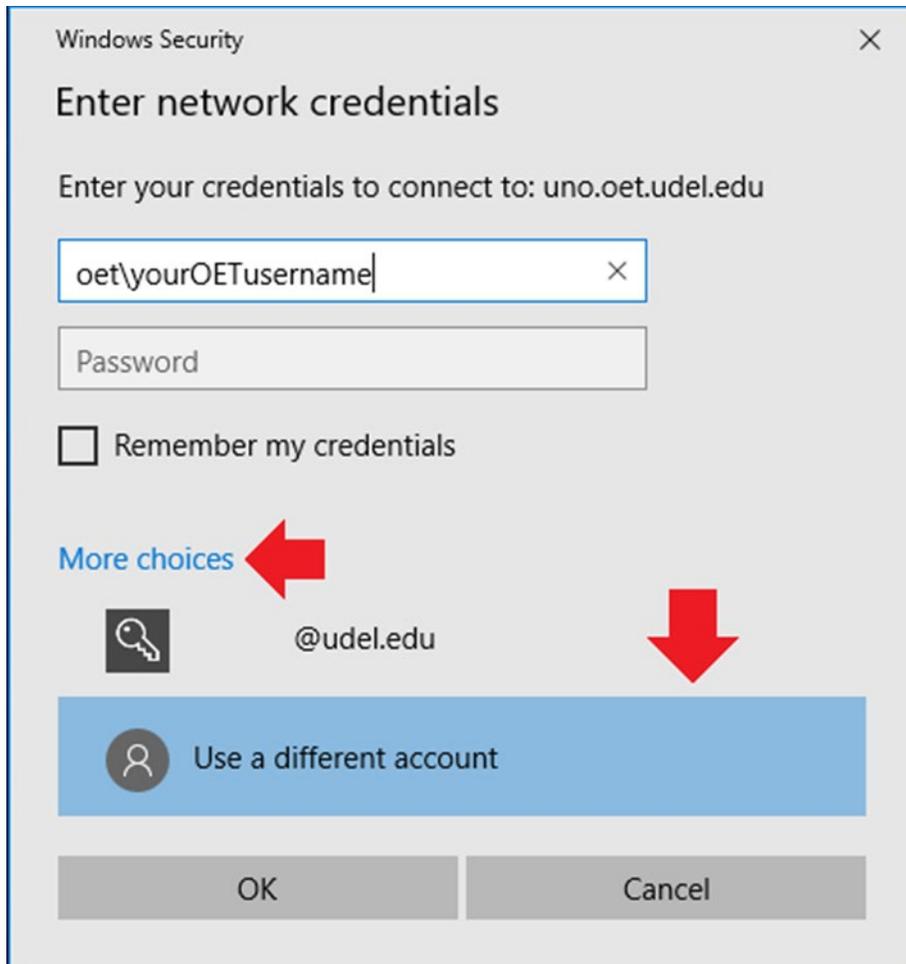
1. Once you are on the OET network, right click on a blank area of your computer's desktop. In the menu that displays, select **New > Shortcut**.



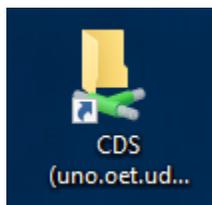
2. The **Create Shortcut** dialog box will open. In the **Type the location of the item** box, type <\\uno.oet.udel.edu\nameoftheshareyouweregiven>. (i.e. CDS, TCS or CHEPDean). Click **Next** and **Finish**.



3. You will receive an authentication box that may have two options for you, either to log in with the computer account you are using or an option for **More Choices**. Always choose **More Choices** and select **Use a different account**. You should then enter **oet\yourOETusername** and your OET password in the box. Click OK.



4. You will now have a shortcut on your desktop to access your Share files.
